## Support logos

The 'Supporting Fight Parkinson's' logo should be used for external community fundraisers.

On light backgrounds, the full colour version should always be used.

### Monotone logos

There are times when a monotone (black or white) version of the logo should be used. Below are a few examples:

### Dark backgrounds

On dark backgrounds the white version should be used.

### Printing special products

Logos are sometimes used in non-conventional ways like laser engravings, embroidery, 3D printing, textile printing. All of these products use special machines that don't support ordinary colored files.

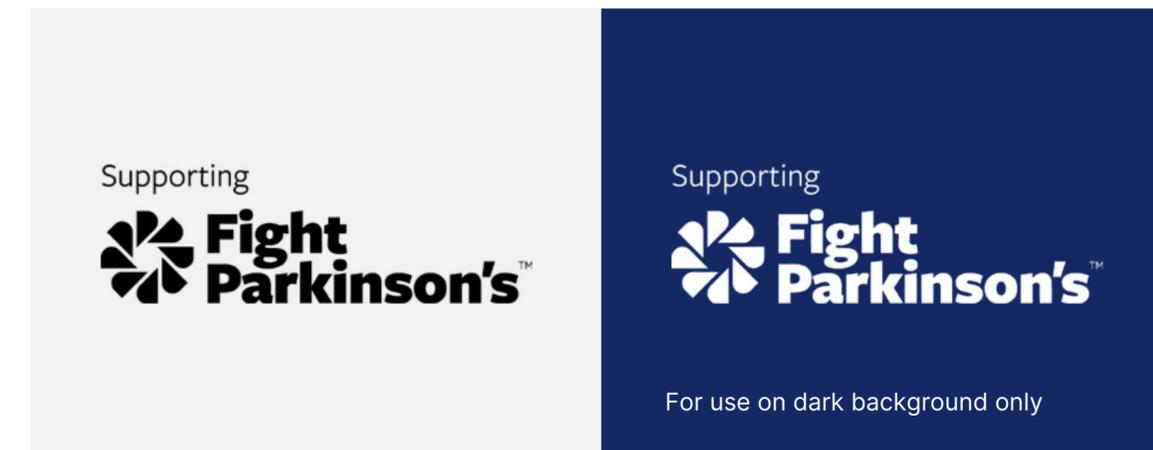
### Scanning and faxing

Sometimes when scanning or faxing a document the machine may or may not support colors. By using a black logo, you can reinforce contrast and shades on your documents to ensure legibility.

## Logo rules

To ensure brand consistency, the logo must not be altered. The following are some examples of how NOT to treat the logo.



⊗ DON'T stretch or warp the logo



⊗ DON'T recolour the logo



⊗ DON'T rearrange or resize elements of the logo



⊗ DON'T use a drop shadow



⊗ DON'T use the logo on a background with poor contrast



⊗ DON'T rotate the logo



✔ DO ensure the logo is legible



✔ DO lock up the logo with the corner of the artboard



✔ DO ensure the logo appears with the trademark symbol
